The Rugby Portobello Trust has been supporting the North Kensington community since 1884. Through a diverse range of programmes and activities, we give children and young people the best possible start in life by introducing them to new experiences and opportunities, helping them to reach their potential and lead lives free from crime and deprivation.

Our Homework Club, Junior Club, Youth Club, Project Athena girls-only group, Magic Mums Club and Football Academy support more than 3,000 local children, young people and families every year. We have a small team of 14 staff (FTE) and are supported by nearly 200 regular volunteers.

Our programmes cost £850,000 to run, with more than 78% of that funding coming from local supporters and small business sponsors. The nature of this funding allows us to be flexible and adaptable, tailoring our programmes to suit the changing needs of the community we support.

In 2019/20 we are focused on expanding our creative art programmes to offer engaging programmes that give young people more access to the skills needed to find and sustain employment, and we're expanding our programmes to focus on the mental health of young men.
